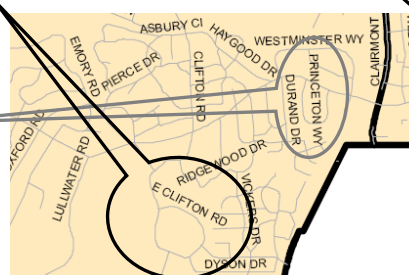
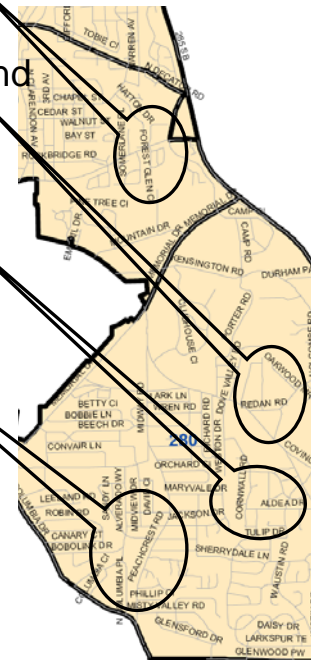
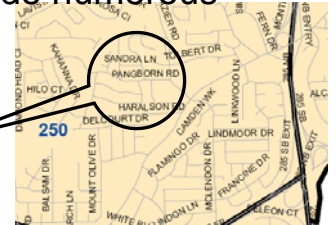

A Follow-up on Reported Burglaries

During the month of February, the Center Precinct Detectives made numerous arrests of Burglary Suspects in the following areas:

- Pangborn Rd area: three (3) subjects were arrested on the scene of a burglary in progress and could be connected to other burglaries in the area
- Forest Glen & Avondale Station: one (1) subject was arrested and could possibly be connected to other burglaries in the area
- Kensington & Redan Rd area: two (2) subjects were arrested and charged with 2 burglaries and possibly connected to additional
- Turner Heights Rd area: one (1) subject was arrested near the scene of a burglary; all property taken was recovered
- Peachcrest Rd area: one (1) subject arrested near the burglary scene in possession of a television
- Emory area: one (1) subject arrested and charged with burglary



NOTE: Princeton Way area: one (1) subject was arrested for 2 incidents of entering auto
